In the interest of keeping our attendees, exhibitors, staff, and partners safe, we have put together our Covid-19 Guidelines. ### **Preliminary Covid-19 Protocol and Safety Measures**

It is suggested that you not attend this event if during the 14 days prior you will have been to a place where travel restrictions have been implemented or have traveled to a country designated by the CDC as Level 2 or higher; have been in contact with anyone who has been diagnosed with corona virus; or have had symptoms, such as:

- Fever
- Cough
- Shortness of breath or difficulty breathing
- Chills or Muscle Pain
- Sore Throat or New loss of taste or smell
- Gastrointestinal symptoms like nausea, vomiting, or diarrhea

### **During this Event, we will be taking the following precautionary measures**

- We will follow Social Distancing Guidelines requesting a healthy distance of 6 ft. The festival will mark the grounds for lines in front of the Gate, Bourbon, Beer, Food, and other tents encouraging Social Distance.
- All staff and exhibitors will be wearing Masks and request all attendees do the same
- First Aid Area will be providing Temperature Checks
- Hand Sanitizing Stations will be available throughout
- A "No Hand-Shake Policy" while practicing good Hygiene
- No social congregating at any area of the Festival
- Staff & Exhibitors will have continuous sanitizing of all surfaces commonly touched on a regular basis
- Signage will be posted throughout the grounds for reminders and encouragement of Social Distancing, as well as personnel for enforcement
- Glasses for this event are for the use of persons tasting and drinking bourbon & beer, with no other person handling the glass

We will continue to carefully monitor the situation and do everything possible to ensure the Bourbon Beer & BBQ Festival is held in a safe manner. We will follow all federal, state and local health department guidelines so we all can participate with a feeling of safety and confidence.
